## **NEW CASE MANAGEMENT SYSTEM: WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW**

The Superior Court of California, County of San Joaquin, will transition to our new case management system, e-Court, effective **August 24, 2026**. Our goal is to create efficiencies to better serve our court users.

To help minimize disruption during the transition, please note the following important dates and changes.

### **eFiling & payment system**

All case types will not be available from August 21<sup>st</sup> at 5:00 PM through August 24<sup>th</sup> at 8:00 AM.

### **ATP (Ability to Pay) Payment Portal**

Financial hardship requests will not be available August 17<sup>th</sup> at 5:00 PM through August 24<sup>th</sup> at 8:00 AM. Please visit our [traffic website](#) for alternative options.

### **Case Search Public Portal (Currently FCE)**

The Court's online case information portal will be unavailable from August 21<sup>st</sup> at 5:00 PM through August 24<sup>th</sup> at 8:00 AM.

### **eCourt | New Case Management System**

Starting August 24, 2026, at 8:00 AM, anyone wishing to access public court records via eCourt will need to create a user account which requires registration to log in. Please note the following tutorial video will not be available for public viewing until August 23, 2026.
